

Each artist may submit ONE piece to the contest by October 11, 2019. Completed art can be submitted to the ENVELOPE on Mrs. Holden's bulletin board (room 145). The winner will be announced by October 18, 2019.

Other:

The drawing MUST be the work of the student. Only original artwork will be considered. <u>Please do not use clipart or any other manufactured art.</u> By submitting a drawing to the contest, the artist is agreeing that his or her work may be used for this project and that the artist is the only person who created the art. Parents, family members or friends should not create the art for the artist
